Dear Parents. <u>COVID - on the rise!</u>

As predicted infection rates continue to rise more quickly in Peterborough.

We have been informed the Local Authority that any meeting needs to remain virtual for the time being, and that any adult visiting school, or the school office, needs to wear a mask and attempt social distancing where ever possible. We have noticed that absence for illness is much higher than it was in previous years. If your child has flu-like symptoms and develops a temperature, we **strongly advise you to get a PCR test for your child**. Your child then should isolate until a negative PCR result is given. Many other schools around us are seeing increased covid infection rates, as the children are being tested.

May I remind you that LFD tests are not suitable for children under the age of 11.

PCR tests can be booked online at <u>https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test</u> or by calling 119. It is still the case that for any positive results the <u>entire household</u> MUST self-isolate AND be tested with a PCR test.
