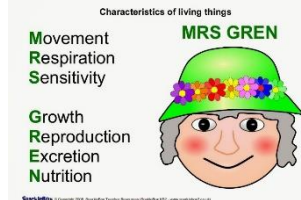


# Year 2 Curriculum Overview Spring 1

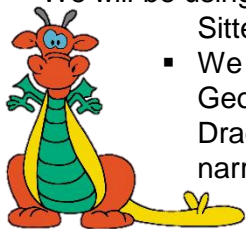
## History

  - Describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain.
